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Early Years and Childcare Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) Training

Training that is specifically designed for the Designated Safeguarding Lead and Deputy Safeguarding Lead needs to be completed at least everyo years, WCF recommend continual professional development at least annually to support the role.

When planning to complete training, it is important that the training attended meets the Worcestershire Safeguarding Children's Partnership requirement Df&L training and offers a good understanding of Worcestershire and their procedures.

Recommended that DSL training includes:

- x Early Help
- x Detailed look at signs and symptomiscluding FGM, Get Safe, Witchcraft, County Lines, Prevent etc)
- x Legislation–(EYFS, working together to safeguard children)
- x Guidance-(including Worcestershire Levels of need)
- x Responsibilities
- x Record Keeping (including signs of safety)
- x Multi Agency Working
- x Child protection meeting
- x Serious case reviews
- x Operation Encompass
- x Multi Agency Risk Assessment Conference
- x Barriers to referrals
