# **Nursery Education Funding**

### Early Years Funding Formula Consultation

In advance of the Childcare Expansion programme taking place from April 2024, the Local Authority needs to develop a funding model to determine the hourly rates for funded children under the age of three. In an attempt to ensure that the hourly rates cændommunicated as early as possible in the Spring Term, we are consulting on the model now. The timeline should be as follows:

• LA Consultation 2<sup>th</sup>October-14<sup>th</sup> December

#### Early YearBrovider Survey

We are asking all Early Years providers to complete a <u>short</u> <u>stegat</u> ding the Childcare Expansion, which will feed into Local Authority planning. The survey should only take a few minutes to complete and the results will be published in a Bulletin later this year.

#### Sufficiency Data

- Select the appropriate Year (2023/24) and Term (Autumn)
- Click Edit to fill in the table
- Click Save once you have entered all of therinfation (the number of places you offer and the number of spaces/vacancies you have available)
