Out it out: Raising awareness of and tackling domestic abuse

South Worcestershire Community Safety Partnership are delighted to be working with Martin Lakeman, (Domestic Abuse and Safeguarding Consultant), in raising awareness around the devastating impact of domestic abuse through the #Qut It Out initiative. We were initially focusing on hair and beauty professionals, including tattooists and nail technicians who have a unique, one on one, trusting relationship with dients/victims. However, we are now offering this vital training to all professionals working in any sector.

1 in 4 women and 1 in 6 men will experience domestic abuse at some point in their life. #Out It Out recognises that certain professionals are in a position of privilege with their clients, not only working physically close to them but also very often, they are someone trusted to talk to or confide in.
